

LESSON PLAN for volunteers

Theme — My family

The theme seeks to connect the growth of the child, the phases, the changes that occur with the care of a tree through observation.

Lesson

Growing with my tree.

Family reforestation of the school playgrounds.

Lesson focus and goals

To study the evolutionary development of the students by making a comparison with the care and growth of a tree. Stages, changes, evolution.

To work on the personal care of the children relating it to the care of the environment.

To promote the ECEC establishment as an educational and cultural engine of the locality.

To create an affective relationship with the planted trees during their growth process and while the students are at school.

Materials

7 Native trees of different species.

Aromatic plants such as lavender, thyme, and oregano.

Material for making the holes.

Soil rich in compost.

Material for the installation of the irrigation system.

Activities

Volunteers will take an active part in the informative session on the evolutionary changes in the infant stage in order to raise awareness among families.

Volunteers will participate in preparing the land and digging the pits.

Volunteers will collaborate in reading stories and conducting workshops with the students.

Tips for specific types of inclusion/handicaps

Pupils with special educational needs. Expansion of the channels used to transmit information (visual through pictograms, sign language, visualisation of videos and manipulation and experimentation with their own body).

Tips for parenting support

Volunteers will be in charge of energizers, facilitating the knowledge between families and collaborating in the good development of the activity.
